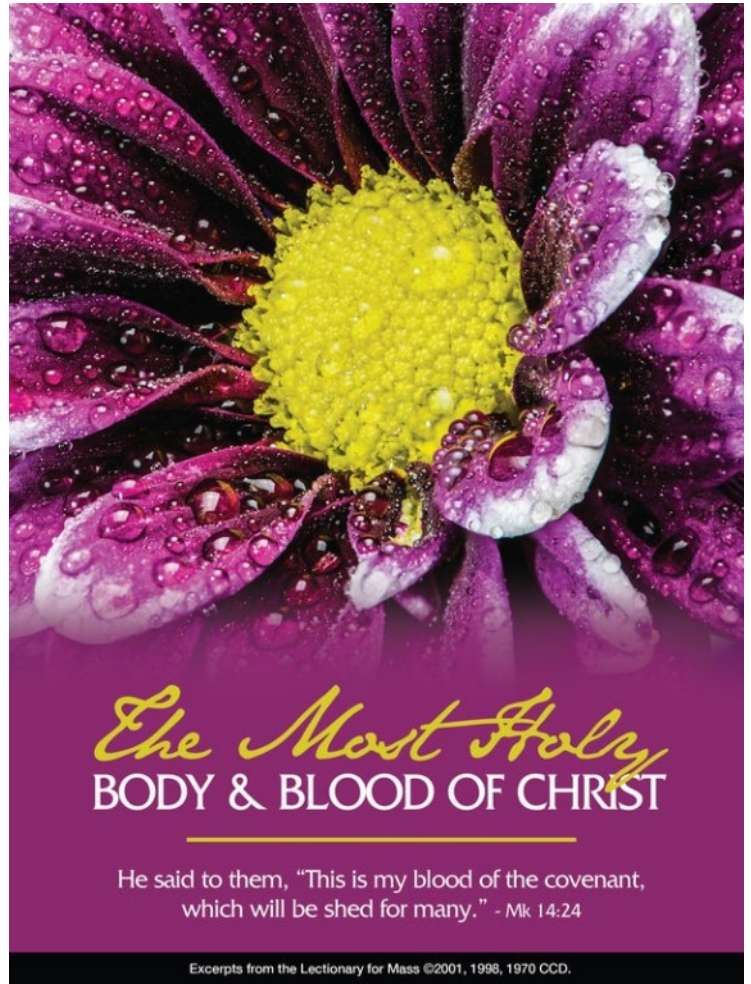
Gospel Meditation:

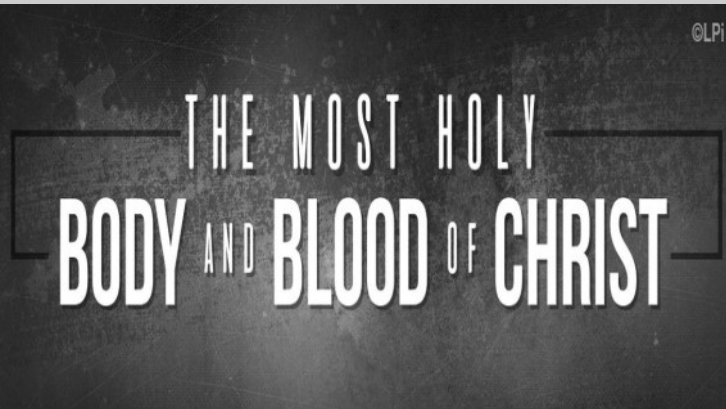
